MINISTERIAL APPOINTMENTS TO THE ESTABLISHMENT SCHOOL BOARD OF THE NEW YEAR 7-15 HĀWERA SCHOOL

Registrations of Interest are being invited for five Ministerial appointments to the Establishment School Board governing the new Year 7-15 Hāwera School situated on 13 Camberwell Road, Hāwera. The Year 7-15 Hāwera School is a newly established Year 7-15 secondary school which is planned to open in January 2023.

We expect that the Year 7-15 Hāwera school will provide equitable and improved outcomes for all students, particularly for ākonga Māori and those students with learning needs. The schooling environment will be based on Te Tiriti partnerships. There will be a strong focus on: student well-being, whānau engagement and community connections. Strong transitions with feeder schools and pathways to employment and further education will also be an expectation. Facilities will be designed to support quality teaching and learning.

The Establishment School Board is a Crown Entity. It is the employer of all school staff, sets the school's overall direction, and is future focused. Board members need a balance of skills and experiences.

The term of appointment for ministerial appointees is up until the date that the Minister of Education sets for the election of a school board. An Establishment School Board usually remains in office for about six months after the opening of the school. By that time, staff and students will be settled in and interested persons will have had time to consider standing for election to the new school board.

Applicants should preferably have knowledge and experience of school governance and be supportive of the goals and aspirations of iwi and the Hāwera community.
